*From the Pastor's Desk...
"Praise God from whom all
blessings flow!"*

This past week held several significant manifestations of God's blessings upon us here at Our Lady of Peace, and upon the Diocese of Brooklyn at large.

Last Saturday we held our *'Annual Parish Picnic,'* and after waking early Saturday morning to thunder storms that were making their way through Brooklyn, *'panic'* set in! By early Saturday morning the yard and parking area of the Church had been set up with tents, tables, chairs, coolers and grills! The thought of trying to move the event into the gym was disheartening, especially considering the heat index inside the gym. I can't remember ever praying so assiduously! Then, *'praise God,'* the storm clouds passed, and the afternoon and early evening threats of more showers, never happened! In the end, it was a joyous gathering of our parish community. The grill was sizzling with burgers, hot dogs and wonderful corn on the cob, while many of the parishioners chatted away or danced to our friendly D. J., *Charlie Adessi!* We also had a larger crowd than in years past, since prior to this year, the event was always held on or near the *'4th of July'* weekend. Since the *'4th'* actually fell on a Saturday this year, we didn't want to create conflicts for those who had plans to celebrate with family or friends. So, with a later date in July this year, there were more people present. I would like to thank all those who helped prepare, and especially to *'Jose, Alvaro, Carlos, Alfonso and Leo'* who manned the grill in all the heat! *"Thank you," all.* We are ever grateful for the blessings God bestows on our community here at Our Lady of Peace, and Saturday evening was an example of his blessings!

On Monday, I had the grace-filled opportunity to pray with my brother priests, and countless numbers of parishioners from parishes throughout the Diocese, as we gathered at the Co-Cathedral of Saint Joseph, to witness the consecration of two new auxiliary bishops for the Diocese. *Bishop James Massa* and *Bishop Witold Mroziowski,* both have connections to our parish in general, and to me personally. Bishop Massa is well known to the participants at our weekly Latin Tridentine Mass, as he has celebrated the Latin Mass here at our Lady of Peace many, many times over the years, most recently, he was present for the *'Mass of Thanksgiving,'* offered by newly ordained, *Fr. Rafael Perez.* When I first arrived here at Our Lady of Peace five years ago, *"Fr." Mroziowski* was the pastor at Our Lady of Czestochowa on 25th Street. As a member of our *'Deanery,'* Fr. Witold was a welcoming presence to me as a new pastor, not only to Our Lady of Peace, but as a new member of the Diocese of Brooklyn. Both men have a generous and kind spirit, and as I joined with so many others in prayer at their mass of consecration, again, I was mindful of God's blessings upon us. We are blessed to have two exemplary models of Christ among us, who, like Jesus himself, will strive *"not to be served, but to serve!"*

I pray that this summer season is being good and nurturing to all of you, and that you are ever aware of God's blessings that surround us.

They have ministered in the Rep. of Georgia, India, Kenya, the Philippines, Pakistan, Chile, Haiti, Italy, Thailand, Myanmar, Peru, the Sudan, Indonesia and the United States.

All the funds collected in the *'second collection'* this Sunday will be given directly to the *'Appeal.'* As always, we simply ask you to be as generous as your means will allow.
