**From the Pastor's Desk...**

*"In life we make memories... in mourning we remember them fondly."*

As I was preparing this edition of our Sunday bulletin, sadly, I received a phone call informing us of the passing of **Nancy Barrucco**, who as member of our parish and our **Senior's 'Golden Age Club,'** was quite well known. Actually the call came in while I was in the process of conducting a Baptism instruction class for the parents and godparents of four babies who will be baptized in our church during the month of August. Now as I sit here at the computer, thoughts of **'birth'** and **'death'** swirl in my mind... **'beginnings'** and **'endings'**... **'anticipation'** of a lifetime to come... **'reflections'** on a lifetime well lived.


During the baptismal instruction class, I shared with the proud parents of their newborns, that within the context of the celebration of the sacrament of baptism, a little white cloth (**bib**) is placed on the child immediately following the conferral of the sacrament with the pouring of water on the child three times. The prayer that accompanies this **'clothing with the white garment,'** simply reads: **"You have become a new creation, and have 'clothed' yourself in Christ. See in this white garment the outward sign of your Christian dignity. With your family and friends to help you by word and example, bring that dignity unstained into the everlasting life of heaven."**

It can be a little jarring when you explain to the parents, that that little white cloth, placed on their baby, prefigures the white pall that will be draped on the coffin when the child passes from **'earthly life'** to **'eternal life.'** When we celebrate a funeral, the coffin of the deceased is met at the front door of the church and is blessed with holy water that **'recalls their baptism.'** Then the coffin is draped with the white pall and the deceased is walked into the church one last time. The **'external symbol'** of the little white bib and the white pall are reminders that there is a connection between these two important moments in our life journey. Through the sacrament of baptism, we **'clothed'** ourselves in Christ and became a member of the Christian community, and at the same time, a promise was made to us. Jesus reminds us that **"You will live with me... you will die with me... and you will rise with me."** On the day of our funeral, the coffin is draped in white to remind us of the promise that was made to us on the day of baptism... **"You will rise with me!"**

The cycle of life continues to spin... baptism instructions for newborns, ready to begin their life's journey, and services to help usher our dearly departed into eternal life. From beginning to end, Jesus is a companion on that journey.


**+ CAPITAL CAMPAIGN +**


