This past Monday morning, we entered into the season on our Church calendar referred to as, *"Ordinary Time,"* a season that will carry us now until the end of our liturgical year with the *Feast of Christ the King* in November. However, before we settle into the *'ordinary,'* this Sunday and next Sunday, the Church marks two special feasts on our calendar. Today, the Church celebrates the *Feast of the Most Holy Trinity*, and next week we celebrate the *Feast of Corpus Christi - the Body and Blood of Jesus*. Add to these, all the events and celebrations listed below, and it seems that this is anything but *'ordinary time!'*

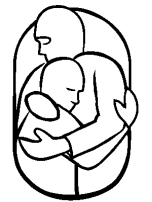
The following events and celebrations are being planned:

- **May 29th: 'Feast of Corpus Christi.'** *Bishop James Massa* will be present as the celebrate for the Latin Tridentine Mass at 9:30. The mass will include an outdoor *Procession* with the Holy Eucharist and Benediction.
- **May 30th: 'Memorial Day!'** The *'un-official'* beginning of the summer season. The Parish Office will be **CLOSED**.
- **June 5th: Fr. Orlando will celebrate his 'Tenth Anniversary of Priesthood.'** The celebration will begin with the 11 o'clock mass, and will continue with an informal reception in the gymnasium. *All are welcome!*
- **June 12th: Celebration in Honor of St. Anthony!** On Sunday will conduct the usual 8:00 a.m. (*English*) mass and the 9:30 a.m. (*Latin*) mass. The 11 o'clock (*Bi-lingual English & Spanish*) mass will begin at 12 noon. The Mass will be followed by a *'Street Procession'* with the *Italian Band*. There will be the *Blessing with the 'Oil of St. Anthony'* at 4:30 in the afternoon and then the will be a 5 o'clock *Vigil Mass for St. Anthony's Feast Day*.
- **June 13th: The Feast of St. Anthony!** There are three masses scheduled at 8:00 a.m., 12 noon and 6:00 p.m. There will be the *Blessing with the 'Oil of St. Anthony'* at 5:30 p.m. and the winning *'Raffle Tickets'* will be drawn following the 6 o'clock evening mass. **On BOTH DAYS, St. Anthony Bread, Oil, Medals and Lilies will be available.**
- **June 18th: Retreat Day for Confirmation Candidates.** This day-long retreat for the young men and women in our parish who will celebrate their *'Confirmation'* in October, will be held at the *Mount Alvernia Franciscan Retreat Center in Wappingers Falls, New York*. The Sacrament of Confirmation will be celebrated on October 1st of this year. *Bishop Joseph Bonello, OFM*, from Olancho, Honduras, will celebrate the sacrament with us.
- **June 18th: Final Class on the 'History of the Latin Tridentine Mass.'** The Class will be conducted at 12 noon, and the liturgy will follow at 1:00 p.m.
- **June 26th: Communion Breakfast** sponsored by the *Latin Tridentine Mass group*, following the 9:30 mass. The breakfast will be held in the gym. More details to follow.
- **July 9th: The 'Annual Parish Picnic'** will be celebrated in our parking lot area, following the 4:30 Vigil Mass.

Jubilee Year of Mercy

+ *Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity* +

The word *'mercy,'* Pope Francis declared in his announcement of the *'Jubilee Year of Mercy,'* *"reveals the very mystery of the Most Holy Trinity"* (*Misericordiae Vultus*, 2). For *'mercy'* is how God comes to meet us; *'mercy'* is the fundamental law helping us recognize everyone as brothers and sisters; *'mercy'* is the bridge connecting God and humanity, opening our hearts to the hope of being loved forever despite our sinfulness. God's self-revelation as a life-giving, love-sharing Trinity of Persons draws us closer to God in friendship and communion. Both Judaism and Islam consider *'mercy'* one of God's most important attributes. Israel unceasingly proclaims God boundless in mercy. Islam addresses the Creator as *"Merciful and Kind,"* believing divine mercy limitless, its doors always open. May this *'Jubilee Year of Mercy,'* Pope Francis prays, open us to more fervent dialogue, deepen our mutual understanding, eliminate all closed-minded disrespect, and drive out every form of violence and discrimination.

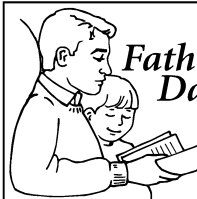
Año Jubilar de la Misericordia

En la Bula papal *'Misericordiae Vultus'*, 2, el Papa Francisco dice que la misericordia *"es la palabra que revela el misterio de la Santísima Trinidad"*. Pues la *'misericordia'* es cómo Dios viene a nuestro encuentro; *'misericordia'* es la ley fundamental que nos ayuda a reconocernos como hermanos y hermanas; *'misericordia'* es el puente que conecta a Dios con la humanidad, abriendo nuestros corazones a la esperanza de ser amados por siempre pese a nuestras ofensas. La revelación de Dios hacia nosotros es un don de vida, un amor compartido de la Trinidad de personas que nos acercan más a Dios en amistad y comunión. 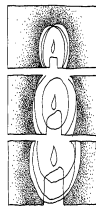
