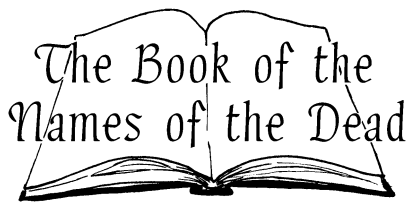

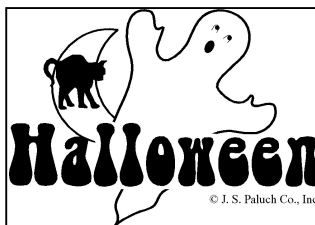

+ All Hallows Eve! +

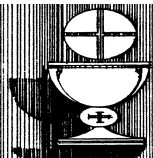
Next weekend is Halloween, or *'All Hallows Eve'* which is the vigil of the two feast days of *'All Saints'* and *'All Souls.'* On *'All Saints Day,'* we celebrate the lives of the saints, especially those in heaven.

On *'All Souls Day,'* we remember all those who have died, especially in our immediate family.

Stories of ghosts first became associated with Halloween in Ireland. It was said, that if someone had died the previous year, and you were still holding a grudge against that person, he or she would appear to you on the evening before *'All Saints.'* You'd be so startled, you'd *run* to do whatever would make your forgiveness complete. Not a bad reminder any time of the year!

Halloween is not *"of the devil"* as some fundamentalists like to preach. Many denominations don't teach about the *'communion of saints,'* so naturally they don't celebrate *'All Saints Day,'* or *'All Souls Day.'* All they have left of Halloween is the pre-Christian superstitions about the dead! *"Happy Halloween!"*
