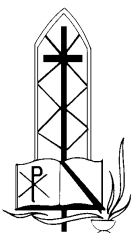
Generations of Faith

**+ Gift to our Church of St. Padre Pio +**



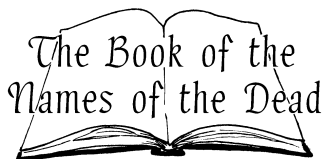
We would like to acknowledge the extremely thoughtful and generous gift of the statue of **Saint Padre Pio (Saint Pius of Pietrelcina)** which was recently presented to us here at our Lady of Peace. The gift of **Celeste Saviano Internicola**, the beautiful statue is presently on display in the front of our church, because coincidentally, it arrived just prior to his feast day, September 23rd. We'll need to re-arrange a few statues in order to find an appropriate place for him. Given **"In Thanksgiving"** by Celeste, we here at Our Lady of Peace, are also **"grateful."** Padre Pio has a very strong following and there are many devotees here in our parish community who pray through his intercession.

A Capuchin Franciscan, he was blessed with the **'stigmata'** of Jesus (**the five wounds**) that were visible during the last fifty years of his life. He died on September 23, 1968, and was canonized by Pope John Paul II on June 16, 2002.

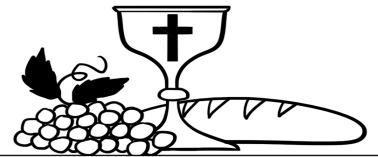
