

I hate to jump on the bandwagon of store merchants who are already decorated for Christmas, and who are already promoting Christmas sales and bargains even before we celebrate Thanksgiving, but you have to admit, **Christmas is right around the corner!** To that end, I just want to apprise you of several services and celebrations that will be taking place throughout the 'Advent' season (**The first Sunday of Advent is just two weeks from today! It begins on Thanksgiving weekend.**) I hope as you plan your family and social activities that are part of the season, you'll also mark your calendars for these special celebrations as well. More details will follow, but for now, **mark your calendars!**



'The Miracle of Christmas'

Saturday, December 5th. Bus trip to the 'Sights & Sounds Theatre' to see the production of 'The Miracle of Christmas!' See the flyers in the church for additional information.

Feast of the Immaculate Conception & the Annual 'Shower for Mary'

Tuesday, December the 8th, is the 'Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception,' which is observed as a 'holy day of obligation' here in the United States (*Our Blessed, under her title of the 'Immaculate Conception,' is the patroness of the United States.*) At the evening mass, beginning at 7 o'clock, we will conduct our 'Shower for Mary,' which has become an annual event here at Our Lady of Peace. So many organizations reach out to you for donations at this time of year, to help those who are less fortunate, ('Toys for Tots' being one of the more popular campaigns,) and here at Our Lady of Peace we are asking you to assist those organizations that reach out to un-wed mothers, and who provide the basic necessities for both mother and child. Just like a 'baby shower,' in attending, you are asked to bring a gift for a child and/or expectant mother that will be given to a local agency that addresses their needs. A list of 'items' they can use will be published in next week's bulletin, but if you want to start shopping, the babies can use clothing (infant and toddler sizes), dippers, formula, little toys, etc. The mother's can use any an all types of toiletries.



Novena, Feast & Procession for Our Lady of Guadalupe

Friday, December 4th, a 'Novena' to 'Our Lady of Guadalupe' will begin, and will be prayed each evening at 7 o'clock.
Saturday, December 12th, is the feast day of 'Our Lady of Guadalupe,' (who is the 'Patroness of the Americas') and early in the morning, musicians will be in the church (**beginning at 4:00 am until 6:00 am,**) for the traditional 'Serenata' ('Serenade') to Our Lady, which consists of songs, prayers and hymns in her honor.
Sunday, December 13th, following the 11 o'clock Spanish



Mass, there will be a 'Street Procession' through the parish, and a 'convivium' (social gathering) in the gymnasium that will include music and entertainment, food and beverages.

Reconciliation Monday

Monday, December 14th, every church throughout the Diocese of Brooklyn will be open from 4 o'clock in the afternoon, until 8 o'clock in the evening, for those who would like to go to 'Sacrament of Reconciliation' (Confession) in preparation for Christmas. At 7 o'clock that evening, we will also conduct a 'Communal Reconciliation Service.'



Breakfast with Santa!

Saturday, December 19th, our first ever 'Breakfast with Santa!' The children in our 'Religious Education Program' will gather for a morning mass at 9:30 am before they break for the Christmas vacation. Following the mass, those who would like to stay, are welcome to join in a 'Breakfast with Santa!' immediately following the mass in the gym. Parents are welcome to join us along with any "little ones" (infants and toddlers) who are still too young to be in our Religious Education Program. And don't forget to bring your cameras, i-pads and cell phones to take a picture with Santa Claus!



Annual 'Lessons & Carols' Service

Sunday, December 20th - This annual 'Lessons & Carols' Service is our 'Christmas Gift' to the parish and neighborhood. Beginning at 7 o'clock in the evening, join us, and bring a friend, to hear the Christmas Story told through readings from sacred scripture, and then raise your voice in singing some of our favorite Christmas carols. There is no fee for this concert.




