

### *From the Pastor's Desk . . .*

**"Welcome Back!"** With our annual *Novena of Thirteen Tuesdays* in Honor of St. Anthony beginning this week, I realized, as I sat down to pen this bulletin, that we'd be seeing quite a few faces that we haven't seen since last June! This is always a special time here at Our Lady of Peace, when devotees to St. Anthony travel from various points in our Diocese, as well as the Archdiocese of New York and the borough of Staten Island. A few years back, I was introduced to a number of women who make the journey each Tuesday, from Mount Vernon, New York. In response to my surprise, one of the women simply reminded me, that fewer and fewer churches are conducting this special Novena. So to all of you who are with us this week for the first time since last year's feast of Saint Anthony, '*Welcome back!*' It is good that you are here.

On a sadder note, for those of you who are returning for the first time since last June, you may or may not be aware of the passing of two very special people connected to the Novena of Saint Anthony. For the past two years, the guest celebrant and homilist of the noon mass was **Fr. John Scarangello, ofm**, the former pastor of Our Lady of Peace Church. Fr. John had already committed himself to returning again this year, when sadly, and quite unexpected, he passed into eternal life on Saturday, August 31st. At the young age of only fifty-nine, he was far to young to be taken from us. Needless to say, his absence is surely felt.

Also connected to our weekly noon mass, was a true gentlemen, **Mr. Pasquale "Pat" Marchitello**, who you may or may not have known by name, but Pat for the man who served the noon mass each week. Pat passed into eternal life on Thursday, January 29th. Although Pat was not a parishioner here at Our Lady of Peace, like so many of you, he made his way here every Tuesday to serve the mass as part of his great devotion to St. Anthony. Pat had also been an extremely generous benefactor to our Church and is responsible for the renovation and painting of the Saint Anthony Shrine in the rear of our Church. In their memory, the noon mass intention on this first of the Thirteen Tuesdays, is being offered for them.

As our guest celebrants and homilists this year, we welcome **Fr. William Beaudin, ofm**, a Franciscan Friar who is part of the Province of the Most Holy Name of Jesus, whose Motherhouse Church is Saint Francis of Assisi in Manhattan. Fr. Williams will be the celebrant at the noon mass. We also welcome back, **Fr. Andrew Sioleti**, a friend to us here at Our Lady of Peace, who will be returning as the guest celebrant and homilist at the novena mass at 7 o'clock in the evening. May the praying of the Thirteen Tuesdays bring comfort and consolation to those of you in need, and may your prayer needs be heard, as they are offered through the intercession of Saint Anthony.






