We wish to congratulate **Sr. Margarita Barrera, H.F.I.C.**, who became an **'American Citizen'** this past Monday, April 20th.

Sr. Margarita, is a native of Guatemala, Central America, and a member of the Franciscan Sisters of the Immaculate Conception, who staff our parish here at Our Lady of Peace. She has been an active member of our Parish Staff and community for twenty-three years now. She began working on her American citizenship a number of years ago, and as all of you know, who ever worked through the process, it is a long and slow journey. Sister Margarita, along with Sister Irix, went for **'one more'** appointment with the immigration office on Monday, expecting that there would be a few more appointments before the process was finished and she would be sworn in as an American Citizen. Much to her surprise, and ours as well, the clerks at the immigration office acknowledged that she had completed all the required paperwork and documentation, and they asked if she would like to be sworn in immediately! So, to everyone's surprise, and Sr. Margarita's delight, she returned home to the convent at the end of a very long day, as an **'American Citizen!'**

Confirmation

Each year, Bishop DiMarzio extends a special privilege (**'indult'**) to the Pastors of the church, to celebrate the sacrament of **'Confirmation'** with those **'adults,'** who for various reasons, have never been confirmed. The special privilege can only be exercised on the **Feast of Pentecost**, when the Church celebrates the gift of the Holy Spirit. This year the **Feast of Pentecost is May 24th**, and we will be celebrating the **Sacrament of Confirmation at the Saturday evening Vigil Mass on May 23rd.**

For those **'adults'** who have been **'Baptized,'** who have perhaps also received the **'First Holy Communion,'** but have never been **'Confirmed,'** please contact Fr. Patrick at the Parish Office for additional information and requirements. This is important especially for those persons who have been asked to be a godparent for a baptism, or a sponsor for confirmation, or if you plan to marry in the near future. You need to be a **'Confirmed Christian'** yourself, before you can be a godparent at baptism, a sponsor at Confirmation, and in order to be married in the Catholic Church.

On **Sunday, May 3rd**, following the 11:00 a.m. Spanish Mass, there will be a **'Procession'** honoring Our Lady through the streets of our Parish, followed by a **'Convivium'** in the gymnasium. (A **'convivium'** is a type of parish social that includes food, beverages and ethnic dance and entertainment.) **All are welcome!**

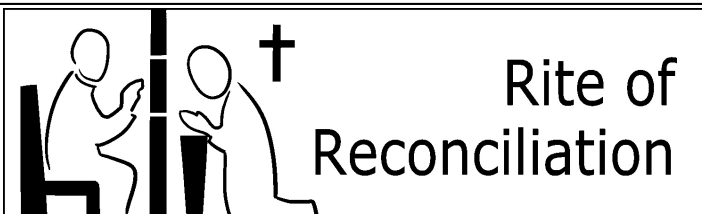

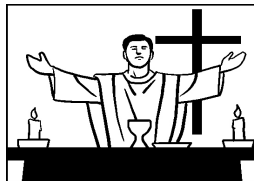
