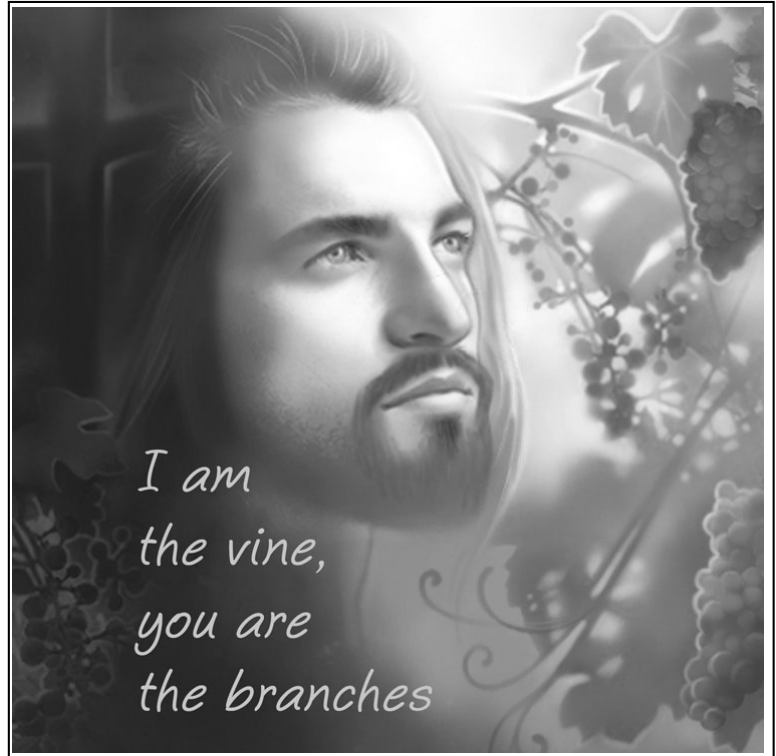

**From the Pastor's Desk. . .**

It isn't often that parishioners will ask me about making an offering or donation, it's usually the other way around! I'm usually in the position of asking you, the parishioners, who comprise Our Lady of Peace Church, for your offerings and donations. However, there have been several members of the community who have asked about the **'Annual Catholic Appeal' (the 'A.C.A.')** that is usually conducted each year around this time. In the past, if you were a contributor to the **'Annual Appeal,'** you usually received a mailing from the Diocese directly, reminding you of the donation you made last year, and asking you, once again, to be as generous as possible. **(You may remember the large 'thermometer' in the rear of the church, showing each week how close we were getting toward our goal!)** This **'Annual Appeal'** would support the many and varied ministries and social services that are supported by the Diocese of Brooklyn, and in reality, they are supported by you through your generous contributions. During the past four years that I have been with you, we have successfully reached our goal! When the **'Annual Appeal'** is underway, I would often remind you **'where'** those funds were going. Every parish can't run a soup kitchen or a food pantry or a homeless shelter, but we can support the agencies that do! You should take comfort in knowing that, through your contributions and support, you are reaching out to those less fortunate.

However, to answer the few who have wondered, **(and perhaps that of you who haven't),** the **'Annual Catholic Appeal'** is **"on hold"** for this year. In it's place, the Diocese of Brooklyn is undertaking a **'Capital Campaign,'** that will, in essence, span the next two years. This **'Capital Campaign'** will address very specific matters that are a source of concern for the Diocese, and part of the **'Campaign'** funds will be redirected to our parish here at Our Lady of Peace for capital improvements.

The **'Campaign'** is just now getting started, and over the next few weeks, I will be contacting several of you **'directly,'** to explain the **'Campaign,'** and more importantly, to ask your assistance in its implementation. **'Money issues'** are very disconcerting to me **(you usually only hear me speak about money matters 'once' a year . . . during the time of the 'Annual Appeal.')** I have taken the road of publicizing our weekly collection in the bulletin each Sunday, and I would like to believe that all of you who address your own yearly budget, can appreciate the fact that our weekly collection averages about **one thousand dollars.** Times that by **fifty-two weeks,** and you're looking at an **'annual income'** of about **fifty-two thousand dollars.** That isn't nearly enough to support a parish Church that involves five building, a pastoral staff and an office and maintenance staff. But we are fortunate, to have a steady income from the rental of our school. But we still have an obligation to support the parish and the ministries celebrated here. So for the present moment, if you're weekly contribution to the church hasn't changed over the years, perhaps you could consider increasing your weekly support. At the same time, I will be providing you with additional information concerning this Diocesan sponsored **'Capital Campaign,'** and hoping that you will continue to be as generously supportive as you have in the past.
