**From the Pastor's Desk. . .**

Although this is the day our nation sets aside to honor the 'gift' that is our mother, it is also the 'Sixth Sunday of our Easter Season.' It seems hard to believe that this Thursday, May 14th, will mark the *fortieth day* since Easter. (*The forty days 'before' Easter always seem so much longer than the forty days 'after' Easter.*) But hard to believe as it is, it is true. This Thursday we commemorate one of the mysteries of our faith, the 'Ascension' of Jesus to heaven, taking his rightful place next to God the Creator and his 'father.' 'Ascension Thursday' is observed as a *holy day of obligation* in the Catholic church, so there have been additional masses added to the schedule (*see the opposite page*) beginning with a Vigil Mass on Wednesday evening. Hopefully one of the additional mass times will be conducive to your daily routine, and make it easy for you to attend.

But today, while attending mass on this Sixth Sunday of Easter, it is also a day to prayerfully remember our mothers, both living and deceased. Our 'Novena of Masses' remembering our mothers, begins this weekend, and will continue daily in succession for the next nine days. George Washington, our first President, said this of his mother: "My mother was the most beautiful woman I ever saw. All I am I owe to my mother. I attribute all my success in life to the moral, intellectual, and physical education I received from her." I think many of us can say the same.

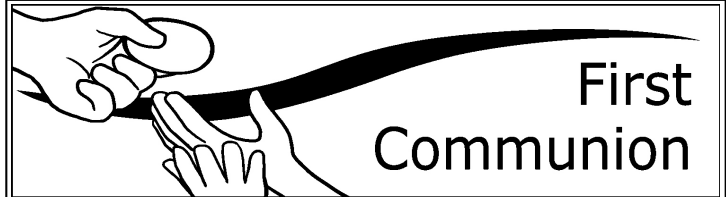

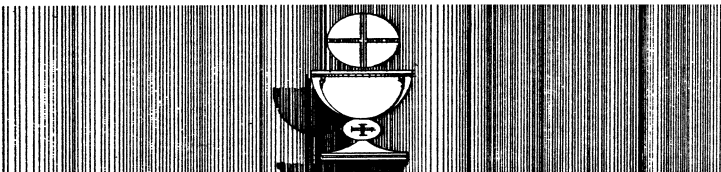

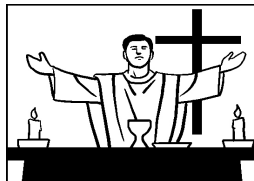
