From the Pastor's Desk...

"Thank you," to all of you who read the Diocesan newspaper this past week, **THE TABLET**, and extended *'congratulations,'* after reading of my recent appointment by our Bishop DiMarzio, naming me the *'Dean'* for this area of the Brooklyn Diocese (*Deanery 4*). I was first contacted by the Vicar of the Diocese, **Reverend Joseph Gri-**

mal di, on Tuesday of Holy Week. He wanted to speak to me first, in the event I had a personal contact with our Bishop at the Chrism Mass that was being celebrated that evening at the Co-Cathedral of Saint Joseph. He didn't want me to be totally caught off-guard. I then waited until I received the official letter of appointment before sharing it with our Staff, and now it has been announced in **THE TABLET**. It is a rather humbling show of affirmation by our Bishop.

Of course, the first question several parishioners asked, *"Father, does this mean you're leaving?"* Their question implied (*perhaps 'hope' that I'd be leaving!*) their lack of understanding, with regards to the role of a 'Dean' in our Diocese. So to answer their first question, "No," it doesn't mean I'll be leaving, and according to the Bishop's communication, it's an appointment for three years. But secondly, let me shed a little light on the role of *'Dean.'*

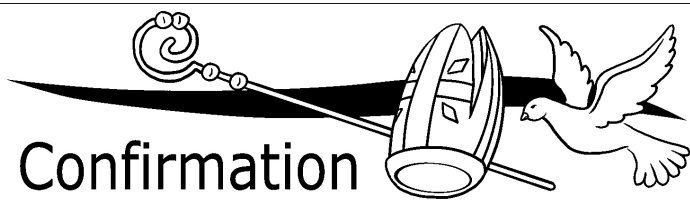
Our Diocese of Brooklyn and Queens is divided into *'Deaneries' (or 'sections')* that are made up of a cluster of parishes that are in close proximity to each other. Our Lady of Peace Church is part of Brooklyn Deanery #4, and our Deanery includes eight other parishes:

- Church of the Immaculate Heart of May
- Church of Holy Family / Saint Thomas
- Church of the Holy Name of Jesus
- Church of Our Lady of Czestochowa / Saint Casimir
- Church of Saint Augustine
- Church of Saint Francis Xavier
- Church of Saint John the Evangelist / Saint Rocco
- Church of Saint Savior

So the role of the Dean is to work collaboratively with the Bishop and the other Pastors in his Deanery. It is a way for the Bishop to communicate quickly and directly with the Pastors of his Diocese, as well as for the Pastors to be able to bring their needs, concerns and issues to him. The *'Pastors,'* and at times their Staffs, gather several times throughout the year. In turn, the *'Deans'* then also meet several times a year with the Bishop and/or his Episcopal Vicars.

As I stated, the appointment was quite unexpected, and rather humbling, and in humility, I would ask for your prayers. Please pray, that as the representative of our Parish in the larger structure of our church which is the Deanery and the Diocese, pray that I might represent you well, and that I might live up to the Bishop's confidence in me.

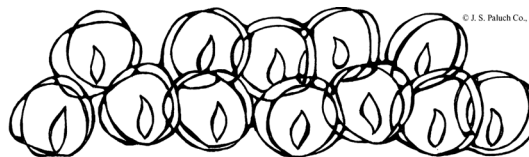


We wish to extend *'Congratulations'* to several adult members of our parish community, who will be *'confirmed in the faith'* next Saturday at the Vigil Mass for Pentecost. As previously shared, each year, Bishop DiMarzio extends a special *'indult' (privilege)* to the Pastors in his Diocese, allowing us to confer the Sacrament of Confirmation. As those of you who are confirmed Catholics know, the Sacrament of Confirmation is usually only celebrated by the Bishop of the Diocese, or one of his Auxiliary Bishops. This special indult is extended to us only on the Feast of Pentecost, when the Church universal celebrates the gift of the Holy Spirit that was first given to the Apostles. At the time of his *'Ascension' (his departure from this earth)* which we celebrated last Thursday, Jesus promised that he would not leave us orphaned, he would not leave us alone. He promised to send his *'Spirit,'* to be with us for all time until the end of time! That same *'Spirit,'* has guided the church from the first Pentecost, to this present moment in time! On the Feast of Pentecost, which marks fifty days since our Easter celebration, we renew the gift of the Spirit, and the life of the Spirit in the Church, so it is fitting therefore, that the sacrament of Confirmation should be conferred on the Feast of Pentecost.

These adults were Baptized as infants, but for various reasons, were never confirmed in the faith. With great joy, the Church witnesses the gift of the Spirit in their lives.

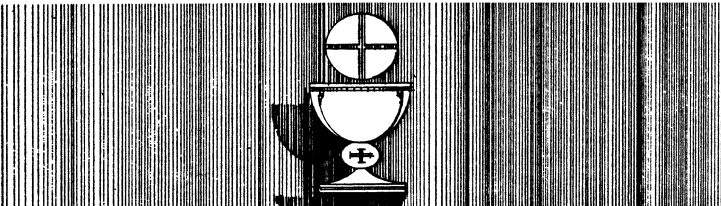


St. Anthony

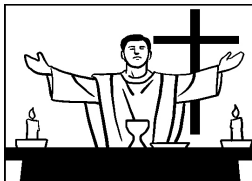
